Pack your backpack at night so it's ready to go the next morning. That way you won't have to rush to the bus stop.




Get up in time to reach the bus stop at least 5 minutes before the bus is due.

Walk Safely




Always walk to the bus stop with a friend or parent. That will help to keep strangers from bothering you. It will also help protect you from bullies.

If a bully does bother you, act strong and hold your head high. Stand tall and look the bully right in the eyes. Use a firm voice and tell the bully to leave you alone.




Stay Safe at the Bus Stop

Wear bright clothes so the bus driver can see you, especially when the weather is bad.





Stay Out of the Danger Zone



Stay Safe Getting on the Bus

Be a Safe Rider


Ride safely. Your driver will give you directions about opening windows. If your window is open, keep your head, hands, and feet inside. Don't throw anything out of the window.



Don't Be Bullied on the Bus

It's not OK to be picked on by school bus bullies. Sometimes you can't solve a bully problem by yourself. Talk to the driver, a parent, teacher, or another trusted adult.





Talk and laugh quietly with your friends so that you don't distract the bus driver. The driver needs to watch traffic and drive the bus safely.





Keep the Aisle Clear

If the aisle isn't clear, people can trip and get hurt. Help everyone stay safe. Keep your pack on your lap or under your seat.


